

## On the W@y to improving guidance

### Guide My W@y - at the thematic monitoring and educational guidance workshop in Bonn, Germany (23.04. & 19.05.2015)

The National Agency at the Federal Institute for Vocational Education and Training in Bonn (Germany) invited on April 23<sup>rd</sup>, both the Erasmus+ and transfer of innovation projects in the PLL (Programme lifelong learning) to show the possibilities and the creative potential of both programs.

The objectives of this monitoring were not only an exchange of methods, approaches and products, but also the contribution of the programs to make the exchange visible. Nine projects in the areas of vocational, adult and higher education as well as the youth field were presented according to their individual posters and they described what role guidance plays in their projects .



The key results at this meeting were that the two training programs offer a variety of opportunities and possibilities for the dissemination of project results. A cross-sectoral exchange is therefore necessary and important to receive creative ideas for the own project work and to learn from each other.

On May, 19<sup>th</sup>, at the educational guidance workshop, project representatives of both EU education programs (Erasmus & PLL) met together with selected key stakeholders from the fields of education and politics. Through project presentations, educational counselling was illuminated from a national and a European perspective.



This workshop was not only to get an overview of the national and European developments but also to give the opportunity to identify needs and obtain creative impulses for each work area in the field of educational guidance through a targeted exchange.
