Guide My W@y – A European Career Guidance Concept for International Youth Mobility

In the framework of the ERASMUS+ project “Guide My W@y – A European Career Guidance Concept for International Youth Mobility”, the 4th and last transnational project meeting took place at the University of Applied Labour Studies (HdBA) in Mannheim, Germany the 8th of July, 2016. Therefore, all project partners from Germany, Lithuania, Poland, Spain and Czech Republic were invited.

The meeting was opened with a warmly welcome by the project leader Prof. Dr. Florian Kreuzer. In the following, Mr. Thomas Jäger held a presentation about the financial administration of the project. There upon, Ms. Elena Iuga presented a detailed evaluation of the eGuidance Concept. The concept has been developed for European counsellors in the context of international youth mobility. These counsellors can use different online tools, such as podcasts, animations, videos and exemplary dialogues in five languages to autodidactically acquire the eGuidance Concept through E-Learning Tools.

Furthermore Ms. Iuga analysed the former usage of the internet channels that have been implemented in the framework of the project, such as the YouTube channel and the Interactive E-Learning Internet Portal, in order to ensure the sustainability of the project even after its lifetime.

The project meeting ended up in a feedback session of the project, which will come to a conclusion by end of August, this year, after a lifetime of two years. Special thanks went to all project partners, whose engaged work contributed substantially to the project's success.
